Youth Uplift Programme

Abby Tham, from Temasek Polytechnic, and **Kyle Michael**, from Nanyang Polytechnic, were recipients of the SIA Foundation Award in 2025. Both of them are currently undergoing their traineeships with SIA.

Abby is with SIA's Information Technology Division as a Data Science intern. A typical day for him involves learning to break complex systems into smaller, manageable components. With guidance from his colleagues and supervisor, he is not only writing codes, but also developing a deeper understanding of the concepts and architecture behind it.

Moving from theory to practice can be daunting, but this traineeship has helped Abby gain momentum, bridging classroom learning with real-world application and strengthening his confidence for his future career.

Every aviation dream begins somewhere. For Kyle, it is taking flight step by step, starting with a traineeship in the Engineering Division as he works towards becoming a Singapore Airlines pilot.

Aviation is more than just the cockpit. It is a connected ecosystem of teams, systems and expertise behind every flight.

With this perspective, Kyle sees his traineeship as an invaluable opportunity to learn the operational aspects of flight from every angle. He has gained a deeper respect for the professionalism and responsibility that keep flights safe and seamless, and this is a lesson that he will carry with him on the path to the flight deck in future.

Mentoring

Mentorship is a key part of the SIA Foundation Award, pairing awardees with SIA staff who volunteer their time to share aviation insights and practical guidance.

Christine from SIA's Human Resources Division and **Zakirah Binte Zuraimi** an SIA Foundation awardee from ITE, began their mentoring journey in 2025. For Christine, a key takeaway was learning that effective mentoring was not about the number of meetings, but about providing the right support when needed.

This support included one-on-one practice sessions and mock interviews, which helped Zakirah build confidence for her internship interviews and secure a placement. With Christine's encouragement, Zakirah also learnt a valuable lesson, that setbacks are not failures but opportunities to grow.

Youth Outreach Programme

Over 3 days in June, Northbrooks Secondary School student, **Janelle Mah**, stepped into parts of the aviation world that most people never get to see. She saw up close, the people, the roles and the many different routes that lead into the industry. Hearing professionals share what first inspired them made the journey feel more relatable, and her aspiration of being a pilot feel more within reach.

A highlight for this batch of participants was a visit to the Airbus Asia Training Centre. They participated in activities and sharing sessions with Airbus staff, and experienced landing and take-offs on the flight simulators, guided by Airbus instructors.

Each **Youth Outreach Programme** gives students a unique behind-the-scenes experience to learn directly from aviation professionals such as SIA pilots, SIA cabin crew, Licensed Aircraft Engineers from SIA Engineering Company, flight planners from Scoot, and more.

The students learned and discovered what a typical day for these roles is really like and some could even imagine where a journey like this could take them in the future.

This programme features an introductory aviation module on the Student Learning Space (SLS).

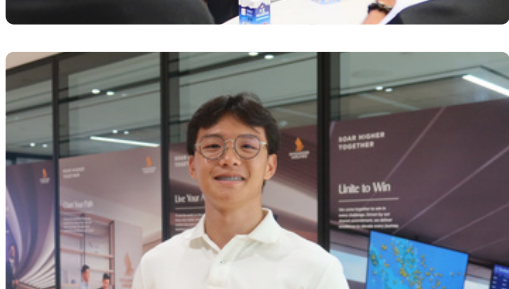

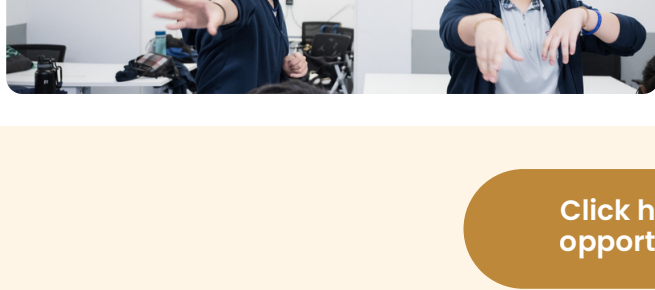
